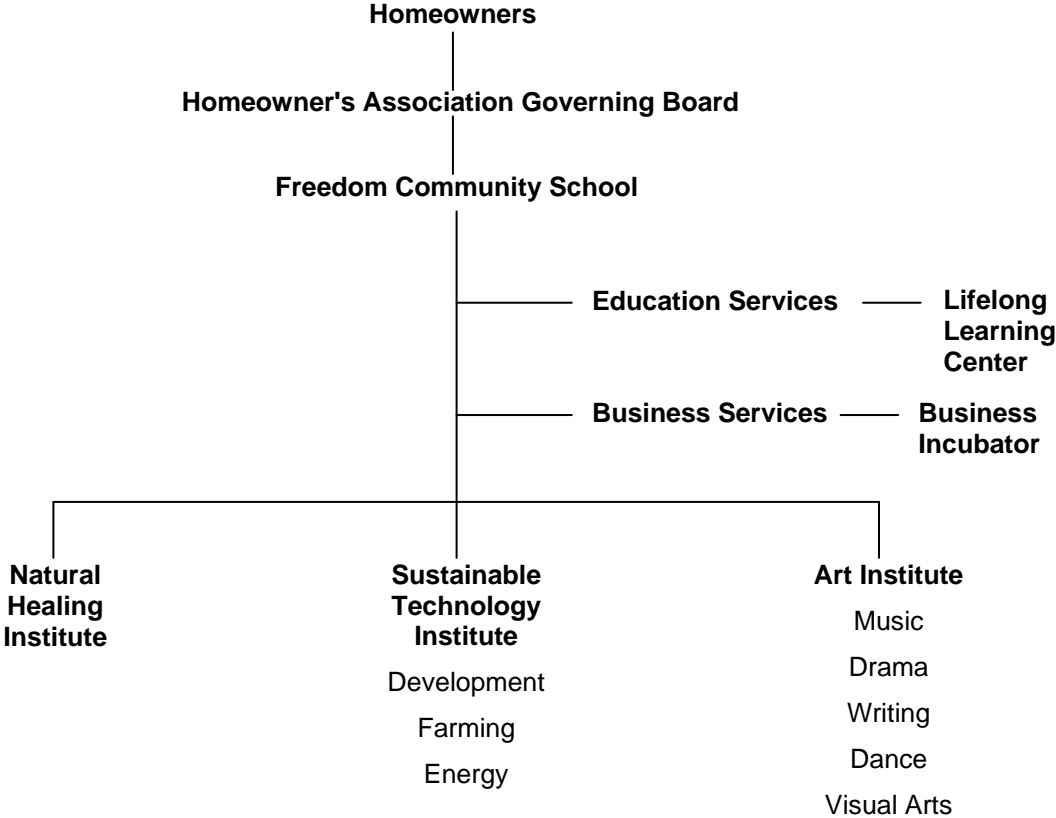


Freedom Community organizational structure

The following diagram shows the overall organizational structure of the community, which is established as soon as all Phase 1 homes have been constructed, roughly three years after the land is purchased. Until that time, the developer of the property manages the School. The developer continues to develop the community until all development and construction is complete at which point the Homeowner's Association Governing Board is responsible for the management of all aspects of the community.



Homeowners

Homeowners own their own lots and homes as private property and, collectively, everything else, including all roads, parking lots, trails, parks, land, buildings and businesses associated with the school, campground and farm plus all roads, parking lots, trails and parks within the residential subdivision. Homeowners elect the members of the Homeowner's Association Governing Board and its Chairperson.

Homeowner's Association Governing Board

This Board manages the business affairs of the Association and appoints the School's President and approves the appointment of the Directors of the Education Services and Business Services Departments and the Directors of the three Institutes.

Freedom Community School

The President, the Directors of the Education Services and Business Services Departments and the Directors of the three Institutes constitute the senior management body of the school.
